- Is vaping against the law? Is vaping safer than cigarettes?

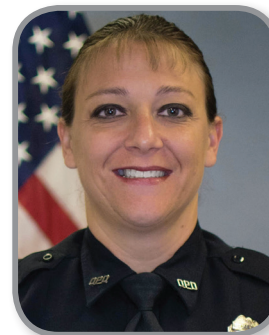
